What is Tech?

- Audio, Video, Lighting, Display
- IT
 - Computers, networking, WiFi
- Campus Security
- HVAC Control
- Does it connect to something?

Pain Points-Tech

- Leadership doesn't understand tech needs
- Plans/decisions made without tech input
 - Leads to mistrust and communication breakdown
- Stuck in a corner
- Ease of use

Pain Points-Owners/Leaders

- “Translate” needs
- How much/How soon?
 - All at once or phases?
- Wants vs. Needs
 - What will this solve...for whom?
 - Does it support the mission/vision?
- Physical infrastructure to make it happen
- Ease of use and consistency

Solutions-Tech

- Discuss mission/vision with leadership
- Master plan for next 10-20 years

Master Plan Questions

- What problem are we trying to solve?
- How much will it cost?
- What is our timeframe?
- How does it support the mission/vision?
- Anticipated lifespan of new equipment?
- Who will install?
- How much do we need to future-proof?
- What's the impact on power, HVAC, acoustical impacts, etc.?

Solutions-Leaders

- Clearly communicate mission and vision to all ministries
- Be clear in ministry prioritization and budgeting
- Meet regularly with ministry heads to address plans, new trends, changes and find solutions
- Spend time learning to understand ministry needs
